## HRSA is Updating the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Parts A and B Formula Funding Methodology



On March 16, HRSA announced updates to the funding methodology used to calculate Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Parts A and B formula awards. Beginning in fiscal year 2026, these formula awards will begin a five-year transition that will calculate funding based on a person's most recent address, rather than place of residence at the time of HIV diagnosis. The change better aligns resources with jurisdictions where people with HIV currently live and receive life-saving care and treatment services.
